Working Together for a Green, Competitive and Inclusive Europe

Norway cooperates closely with the EU. The EEA Agreement is the mainstay of this cooperation. The Agreement includes a common goal to work together to reduce social and economic disparities in Europe. Norway contributes to this through the EEA and Norway Grants.

For the period 2014-2021, Norway will provide approximately EUR 2.8 billion in support to 15 of the EU's less prosperous member states. The countries of Europe share common values and need joint solutions to shared challenges. That is why efforts under the EEA and Norway Grants are carried out in close cooperation with Norwegian actors. The five areas identified for funding under the Grants both supplement and complement the areas supported by the EU Cohesion Fund:

#1 Innovation, Research, Education and Competitiveness

#2 Social inclusion, Youth Employment and Poverty Reduction

#3 Environment, Energy, Climate Change and Low Carbon Economy

#4 Culture, Civil Society, Good Governance and Fundamental Rights

#5 Justice and Home Affairs
