




The first upstream LNG project in Europe


Will link the US and European gas markets

Gassco – independent operator


Gassled – unified ownership

#### **Changing Norwegian gas scene**

- The producers adapt to the changing environment
  - Portfolio optimisation
  - Take advantage of the gas transportation system
- Most gas is still sold on long-term contracts
  - However, many short-term sales
- Major investments could be undertaken without long-term TOP contracts
